Commitment to Pollution Prevention

- Pacific7 carries out its operations with every effort to protect the environment by preventing pollution.
 - Pacific7 commits to continuous improvement of a management system that will, in practice, protect the environment from pollution.
 - Pacific7 continues to actively encourage its staff, crew, joint venture partners, contractors and the wider community (by example) in participating with and contributing to observe Pollution Prevention Practices.
 - The responsibility for applying this policy rests with all Pacific7 personnel and contractors as applicable.

Obligation to not work

Employees and contractors have the obligation and given the authority to refuse to do or stop immediately any activity that will endanger the environment.

Required actions

Pacific7 staff, crew and contractors must:

- Comply with all client rules and environmental protection legislation or regulations in the location in which operations are being carried out
- Protect the environment from pollution by any actions of Pacific7 or clients while they work.
- Work in strict adherence to all environment protection procedures
- Minimise waste and manage pollution risks associated with any activity
- Train others in environment protection practices and pollution controls
- Report incidents or pollution as soon as they happen or are discovered
- Ensure that environmental considerations receive appropriate priority in the design, operation and maintenance of equipment and vehicles.
- Assess environmental performance by regular monitoring and surveying of work practices
- Meet the environment protection and pollution requirements of clients, Regulatory Authorities and appropriate Industry Standards or Codes of Practice.
